I wish you all a happy and relaxed summer holiday and look forward to welcoming you back on **Monday 6th September**.

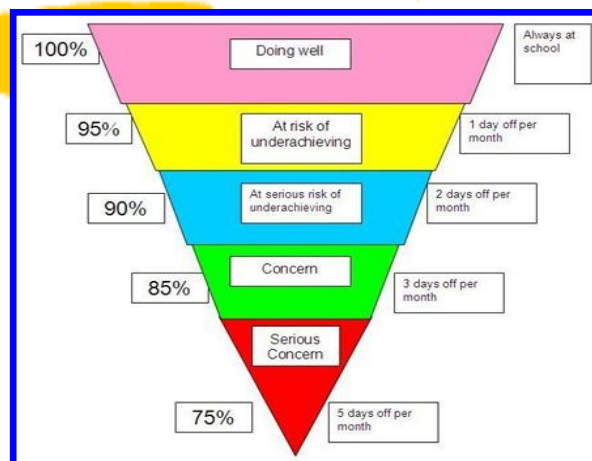

We have been very fortunate to have them in our school and lives and we are certain that we will see them again in the future.

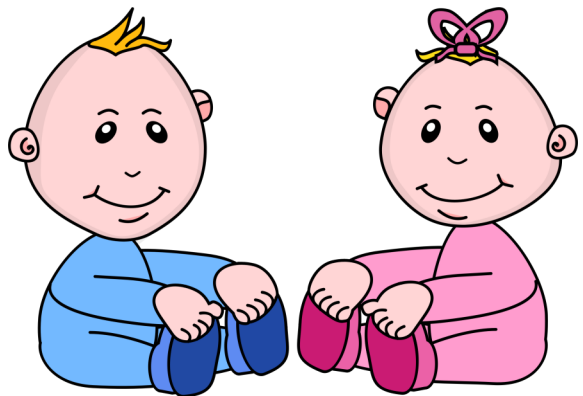
