Come along, enjoy a glass of wine and hear what our wonderful PTA achieved last year and the plan they have for the upcoming year!

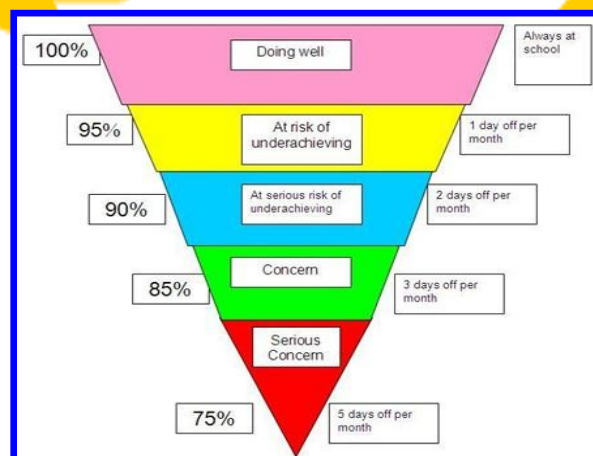

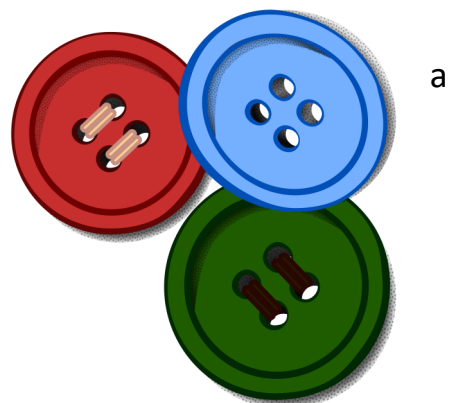
The new curriculum for Wales
