Have a lovely half term and we look forward to welcoming the children back on **Monday 27th February**.

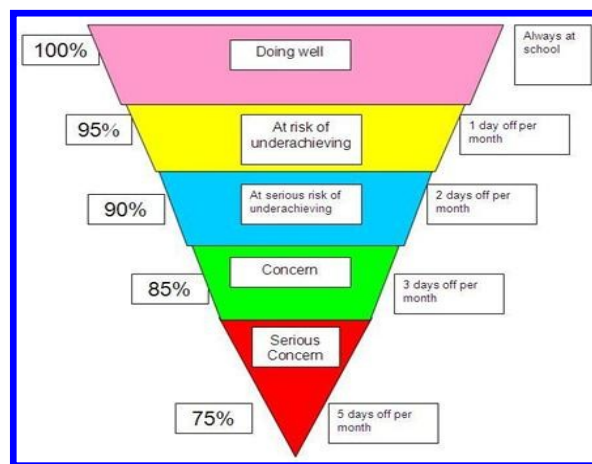
