Have a lovely weekend.

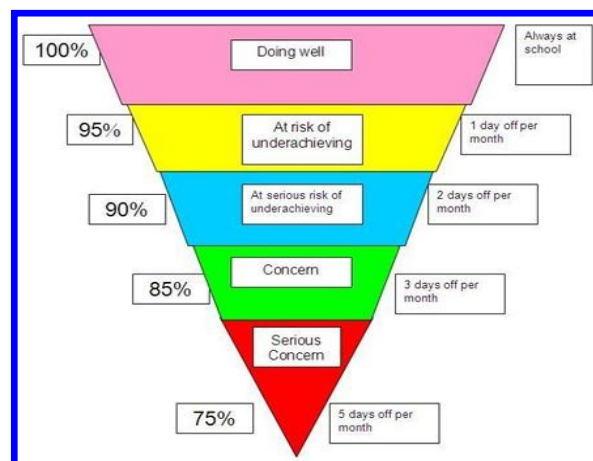

Below is a pictorial reminder to parents on how important it is for children to attend school everyday. We would like to thank you for your continued support in this area.

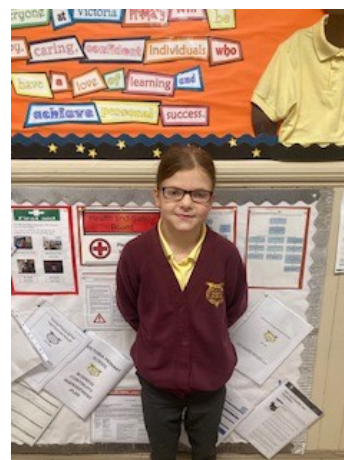
School attendance for this week was 92%. A special well done to Class 2P who had the highest attendance with 99%.

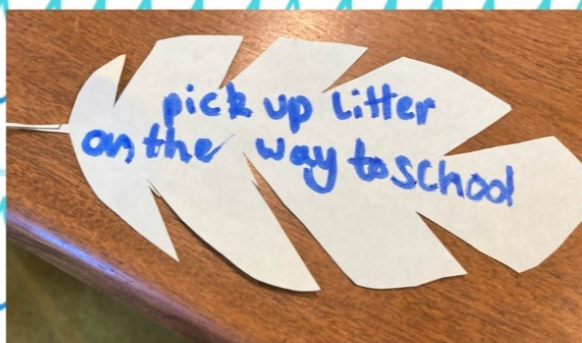
‘Star of the week children take over the staff room’

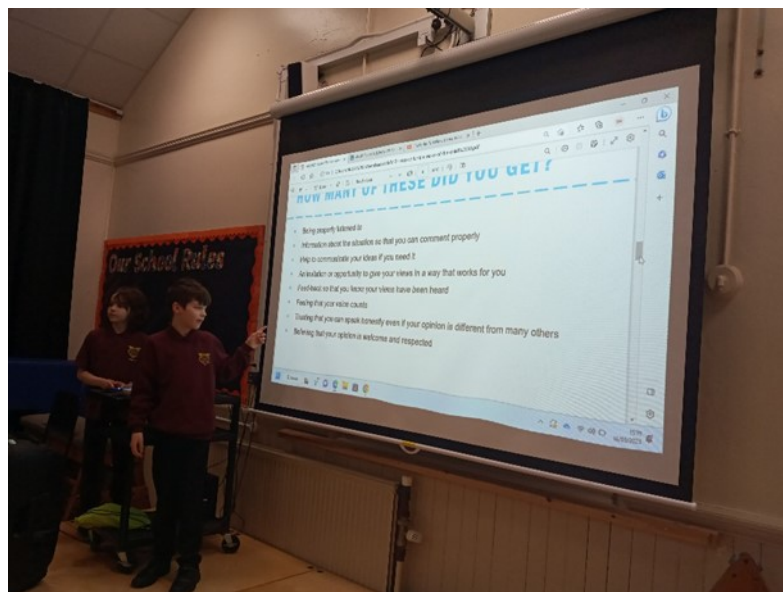
