The family learning project, to create a short story or comic strip about Children's rights, is due in on Friday 28th April. For more information on The Rights of the Child, please see the link below.

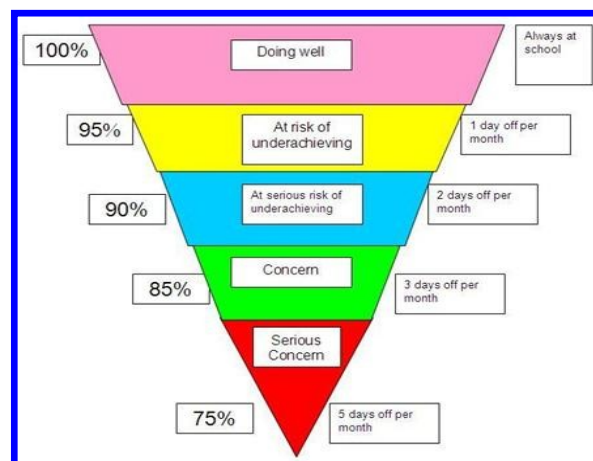
