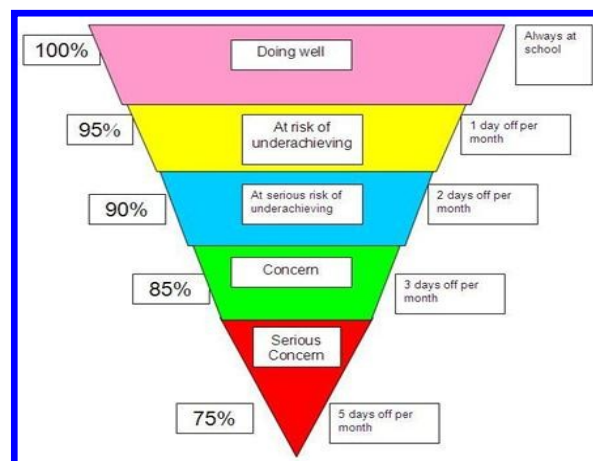

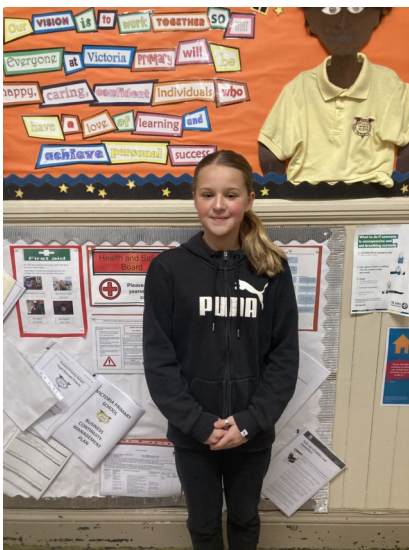
Ophelia competed brilliantly at the Tennis County Cup in Southampton last weekend. She played against Dorset, Hampshire and Wiltshire.
