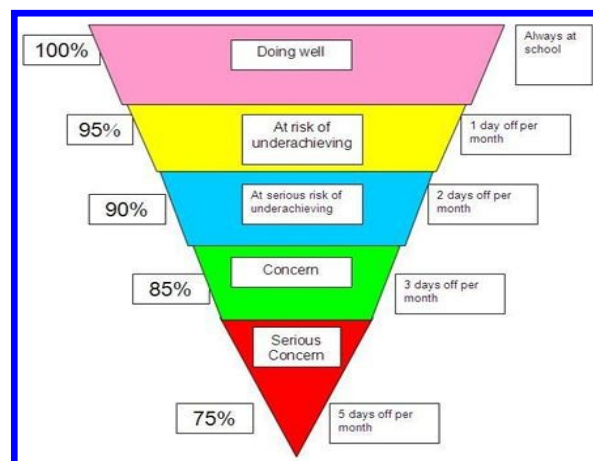
Finally a reminder that I will be shortly holding an online information session to explain your child's annual report. I will be presenting it at 6pm in the hope that many parents/ guardians can attend.
