Have a wonderful weekend.

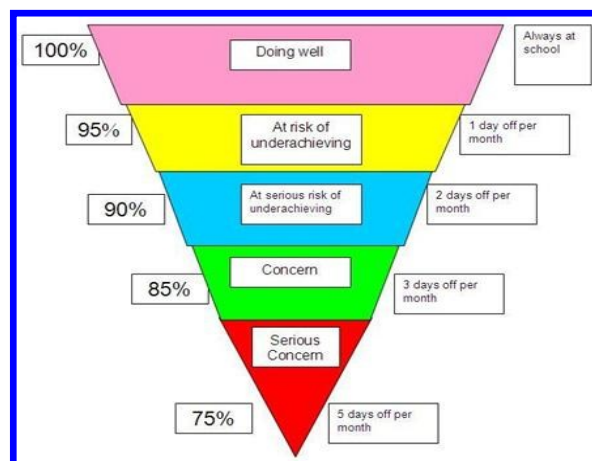

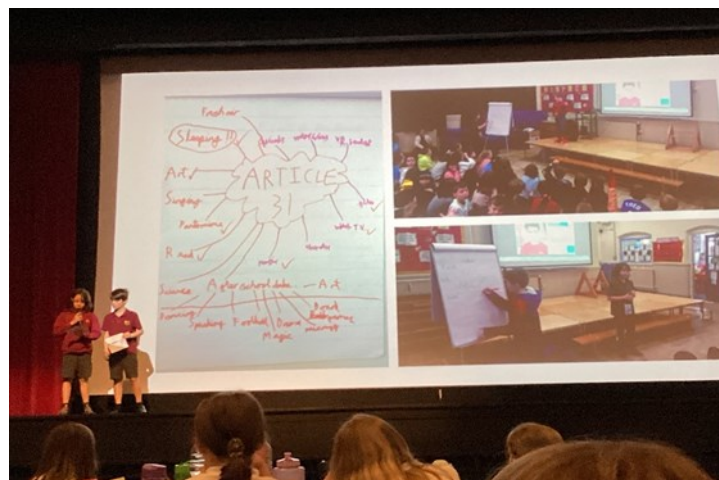

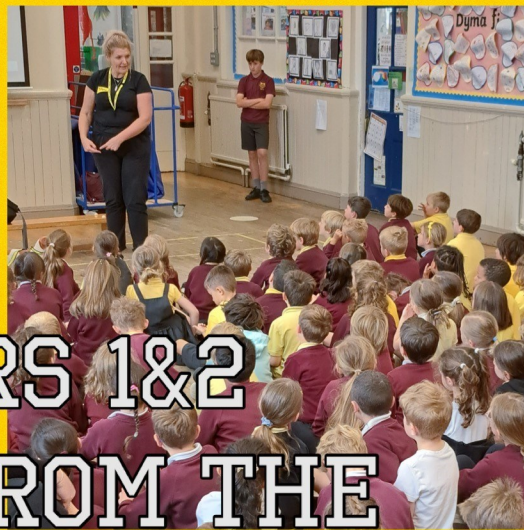
UK Parliament visits Victoria Primary School
