We do hope that you can join us for some, or all, of our Ground Force day next Friday, when we can put all of these beautiful plants to good use!



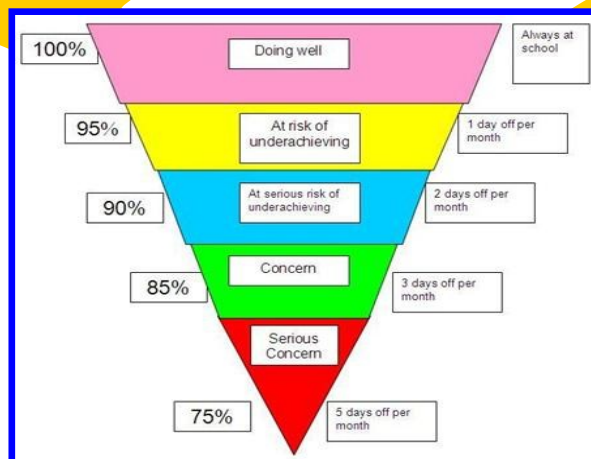
