2km Evie O'Reilly -Albert

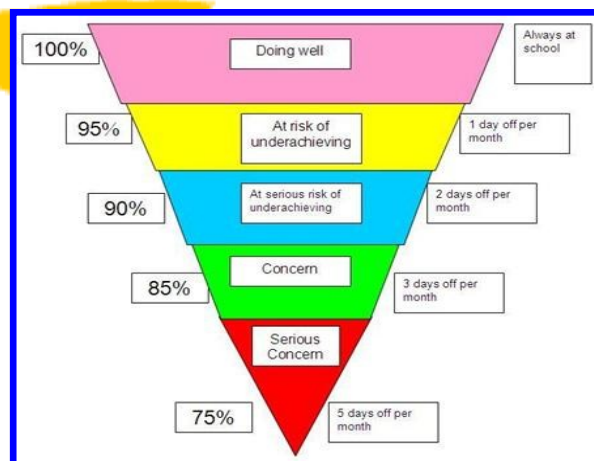

Annual Music Concert

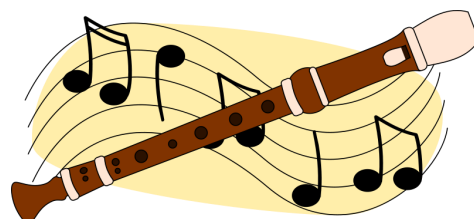
Our music concert this year will be held in Stanwell School Auditorium.
