In next week's newsletter, we will include photos of their experience.

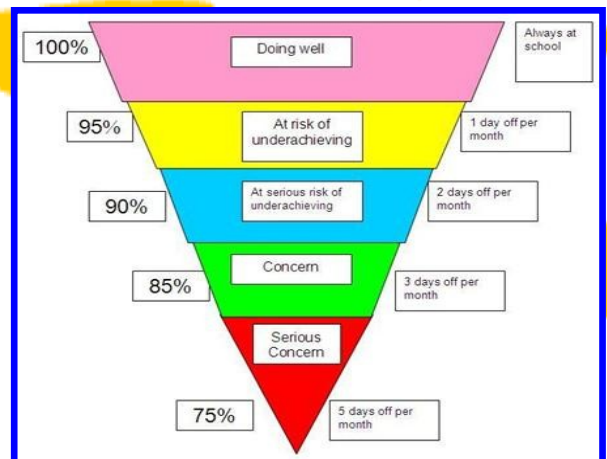
