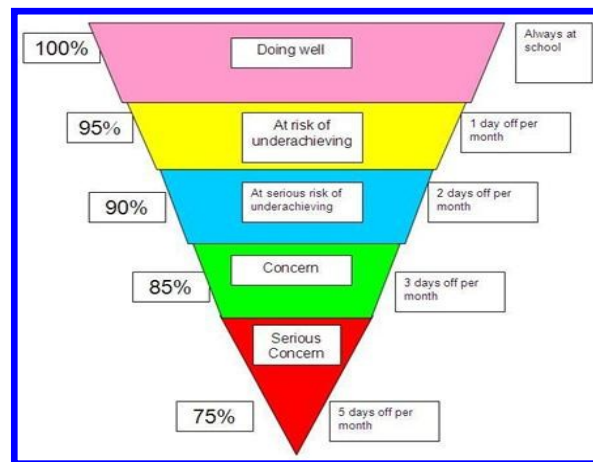

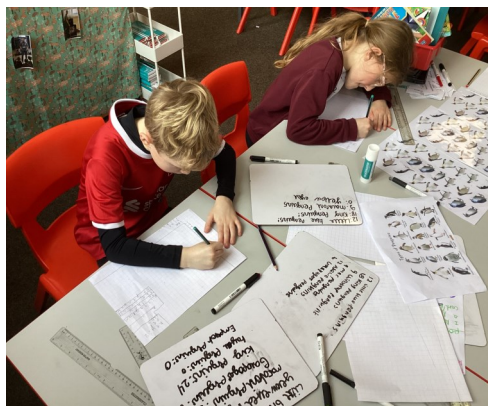

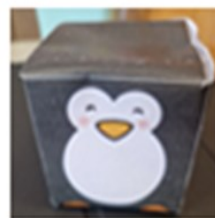
We have enjoyed dressing up with numbers today and, from Nursery to Y6, we have all used the book '365 Penguins' to inspire our maths work.

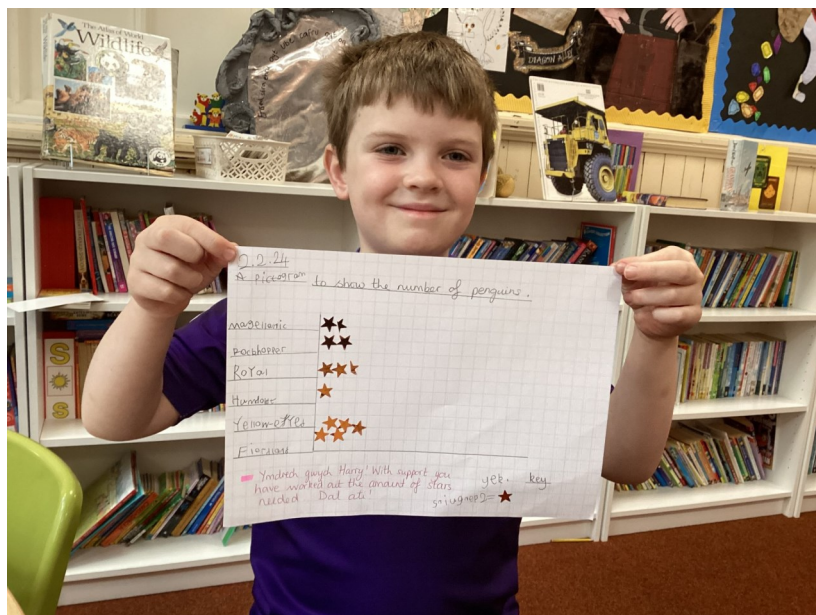


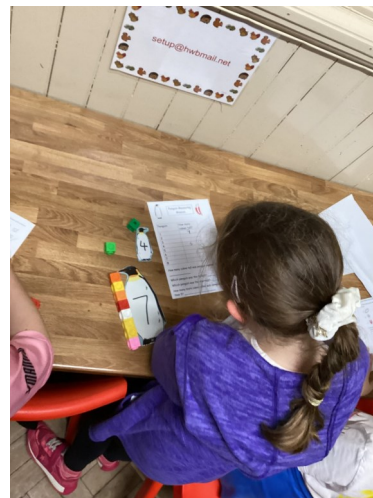
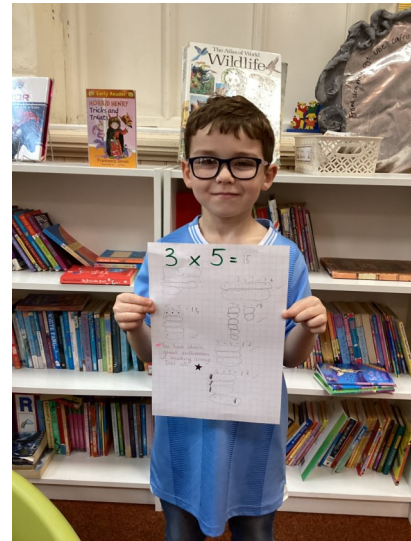
