Thank you for your ongoing support. Have a lovely holiday and we look forward to seeing the children back on **Monday 8th April**.

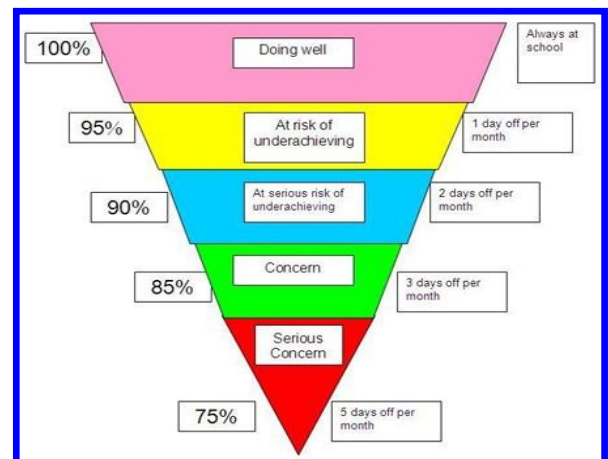
