We are extremely pleased and proud to announce that we have recently been awarded with the Siarter Iaith Cymraeg Campus Bronze award.

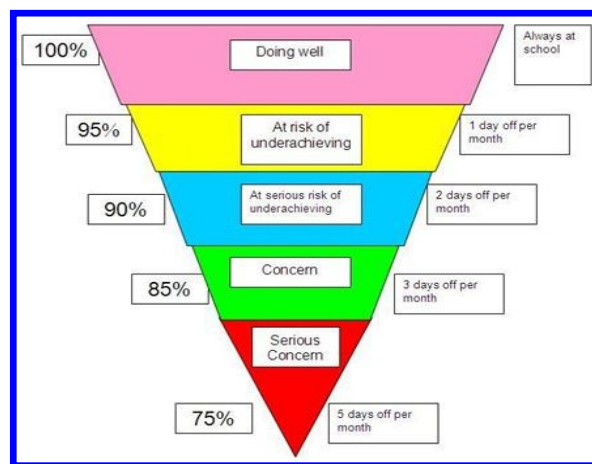
A special thank you to Miss Smith and the Criw Cymraeg for keeping us focused on improving our Welsh language skills.

The learning will move from growing and lifecycles with our younger children to puberty with our older children. Please contact the class teacher if you require any further information.

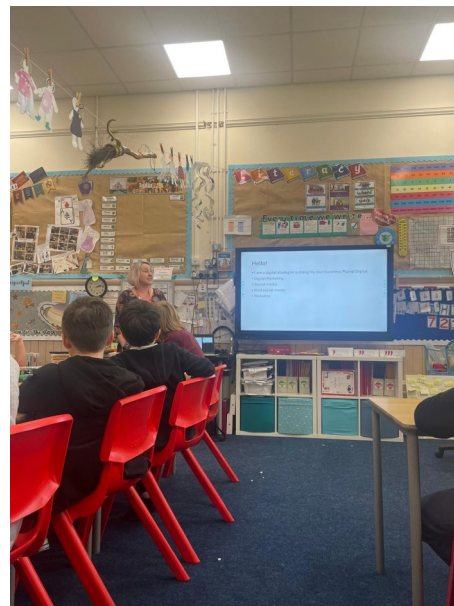
We are currently restocking our period resources in the front entrance, with reusable pants and pads available next week.
