Have a lovely long weekend and we will see you on **Tuesday 23rd April**.

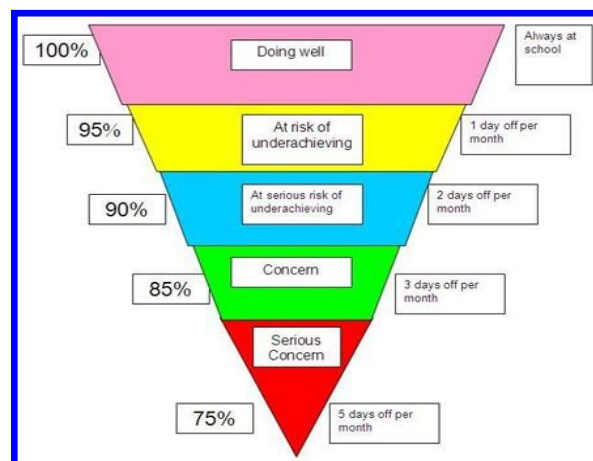
