HEADTEACHER'S THOUGHTS THIS WEEK

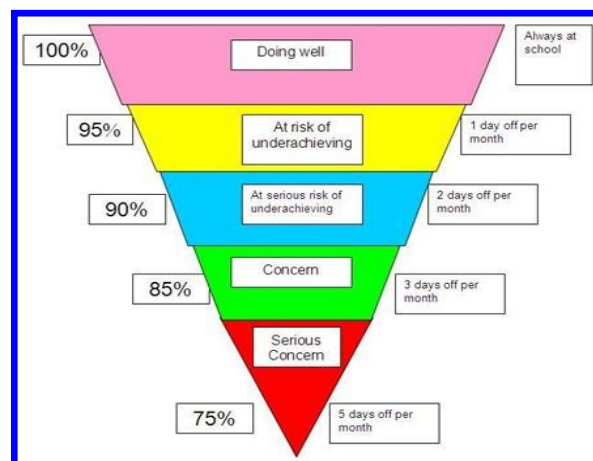
Dear Parent/carers,
