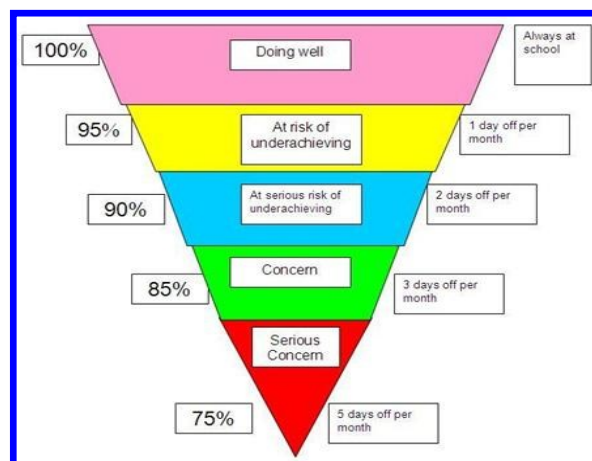
Have a lovely half term holiday and we look forward to welcoming you back on **Monday 3rd June**.
