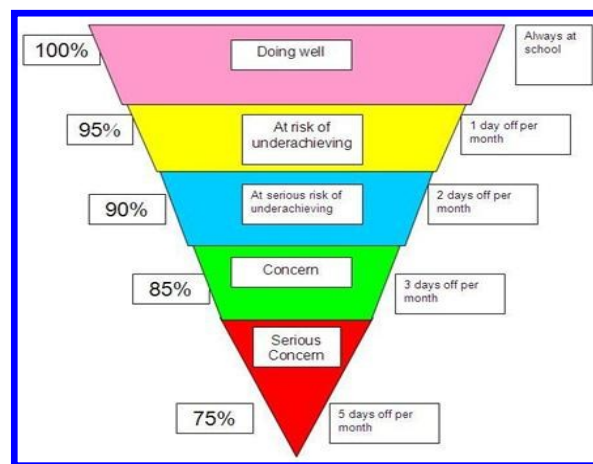

Safeguarding Concerns
