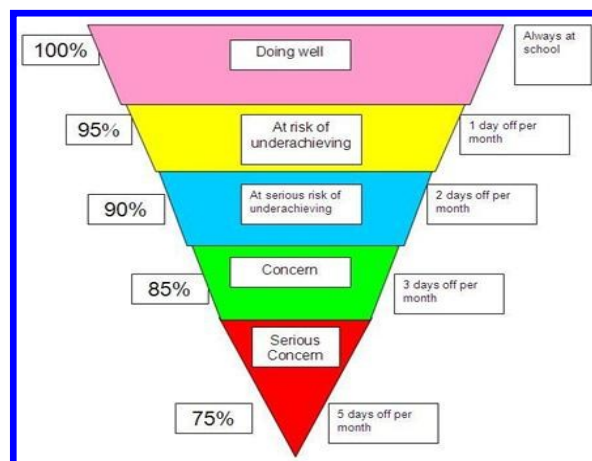
HEADTEACHER'S THOUGHTS THIS WEEK

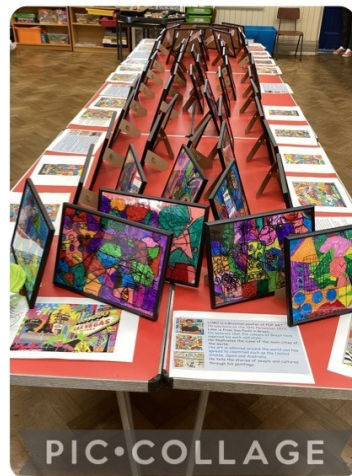
Congratulations to Cornerswell House
