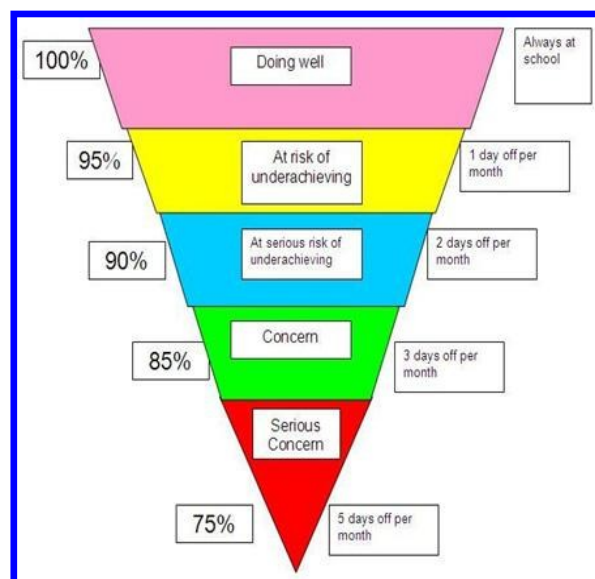

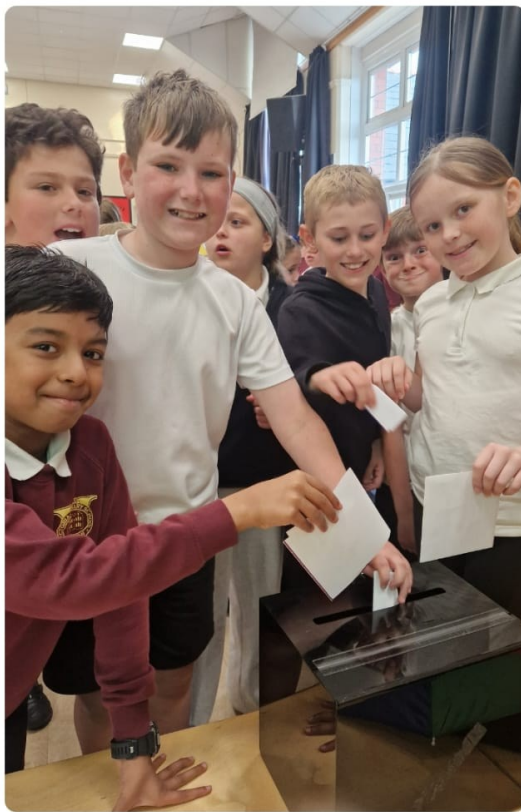

No Outsiders



Each week, in our 'No Outsiders' assembly, we ask the children 'What do you see in this picture? What do you notice? What might this story be about?'



This week in our No Outsiders assembly, we learned about a remarkable 5-year-old skater, Paige Tobin.

We watched a video of Paige confidently dropping into a 12-foot skate bowl — not in 'typical' skate gear, but wearing a princess dress, rainbow socks, and a leopard print helmet! This sparked a great discussion with the children: what do skaters usually wear? And more importantly... does it really matter?

Paige is being celebrated for her individuality. We explored what this means — being proud of who you are, making your own choices, and not feeling like you have to follow the crowd.

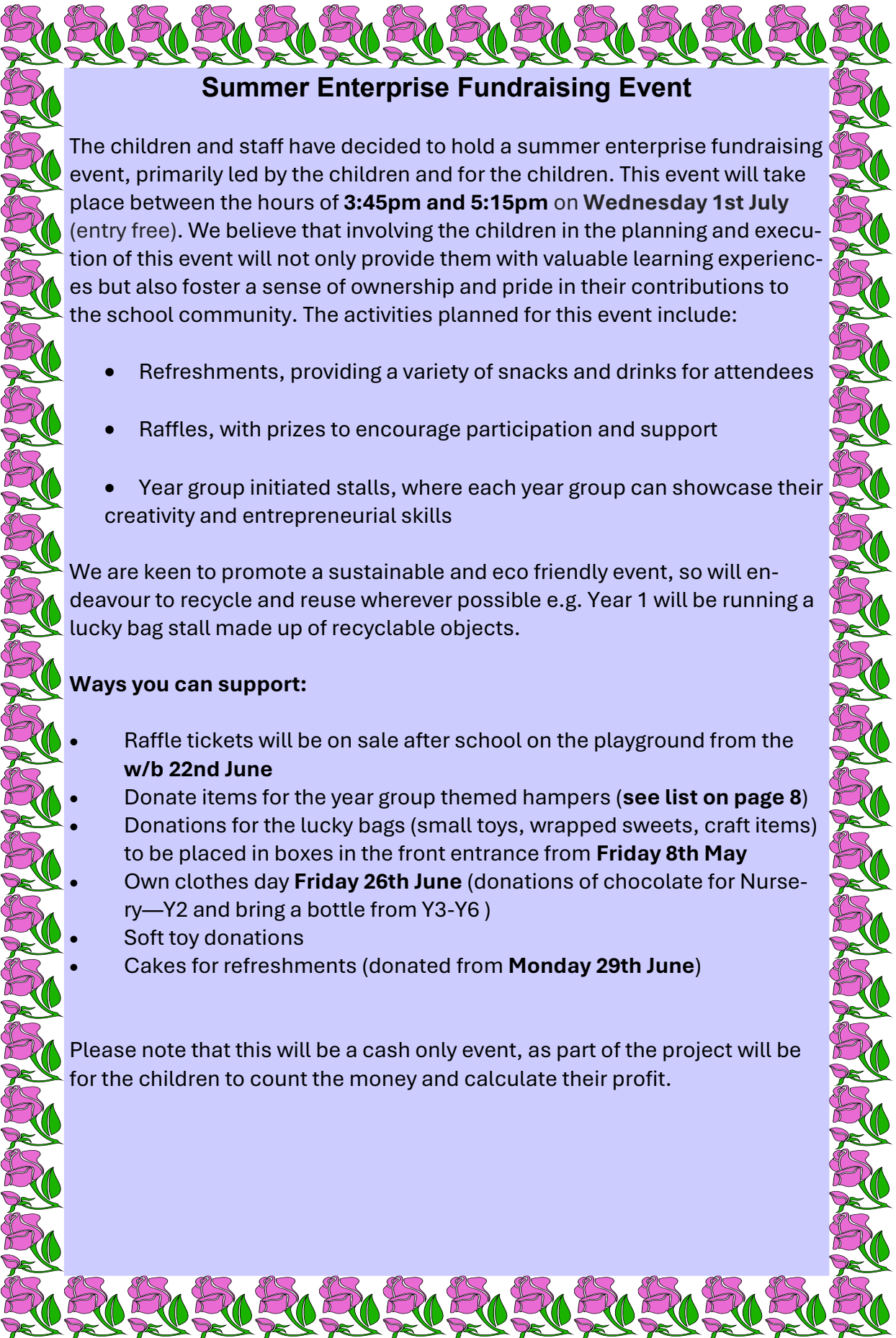
We also talked about how Paige has become such a skilled skater. The children quickly noticed that it didn't happen overnight. Paige practices again and again. She sometimes falls, but she gets back up and keeps trying. Her determination is what helps her improve - she never gives up.

We encourage you to discuss further with your child. Some ideas for discussion points could be:

Why do you think Paige sometimes chooses to wear a princess dress while skating?

What could she say if someone told her she was wearing the "wrong" clothes?

What can we learn from Paige about being ourselves and not giving up?



Summer Enterprise Fundraising Event

The children and staff have decided to hold a summer enterprise fundraising event, primarily led by the children and for the children.
