Have a lovely weekend.

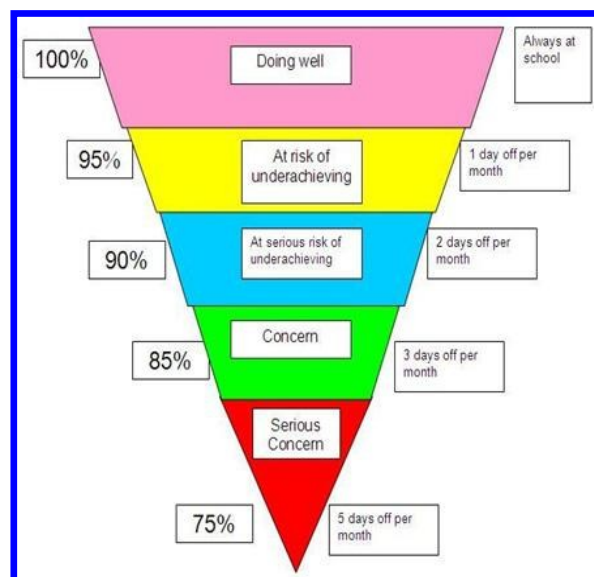

You raised £88.40 for Ty Hafan. Diolch yn fawr iawn!

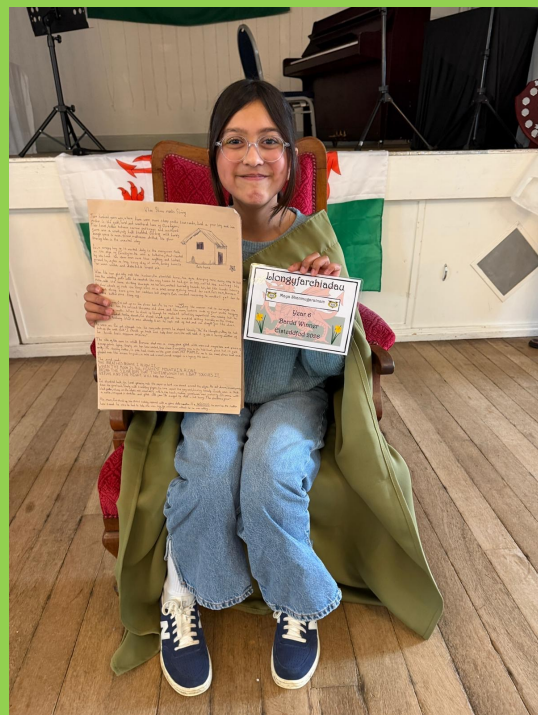


Farewell to Rose

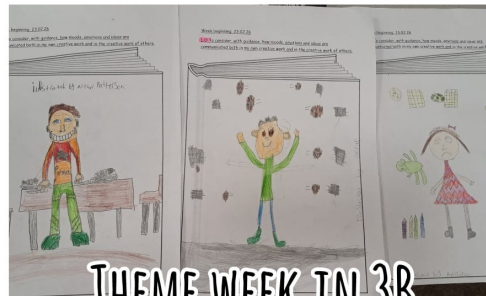
