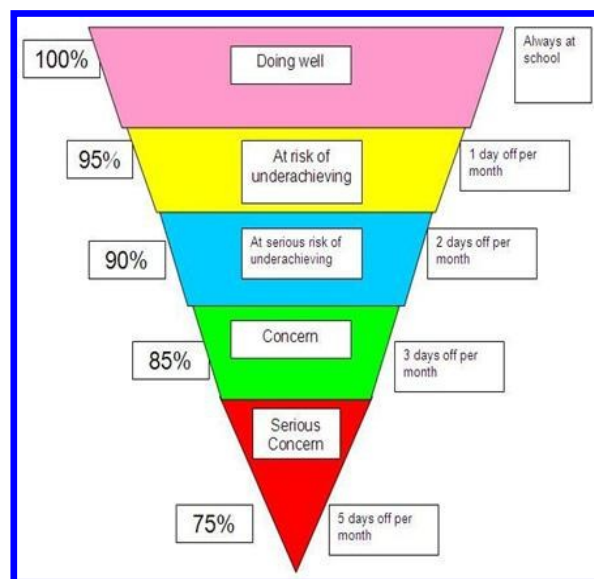
HEADTEACHER'S THOUGHTS THIS WEEK

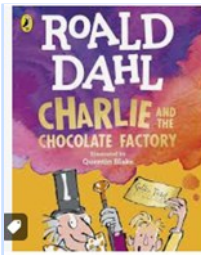

The quiz was designed by Mrs Davies to celebrate Dahl's wonderful stories and unforgettable characters as part of our theme week on illustrators. Children competed in their houses: Stanwell, Meliden, Cornerswell and Baron which they loved. They were asked a range of fun and challenging questions about some of Roald Dahl's best-loved books, including Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, Matilda, The BFG, and The Twits.

From naming Willy Wonka's rival chocolate maker to remembering that Mrs Twit put worms in Mrs Twit's spaghetti, the children impressed us all with their fantastic knowledge and enthusiasm.
