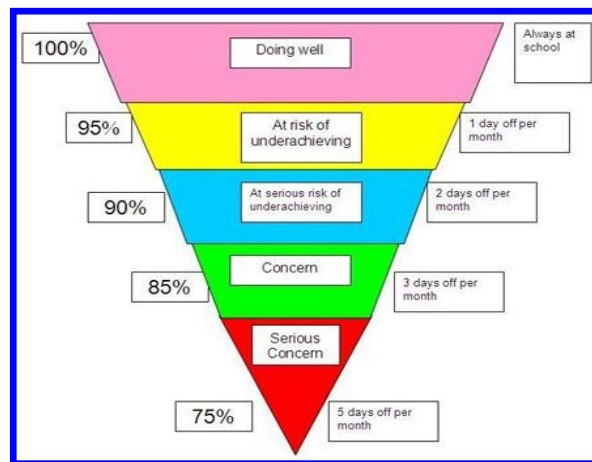

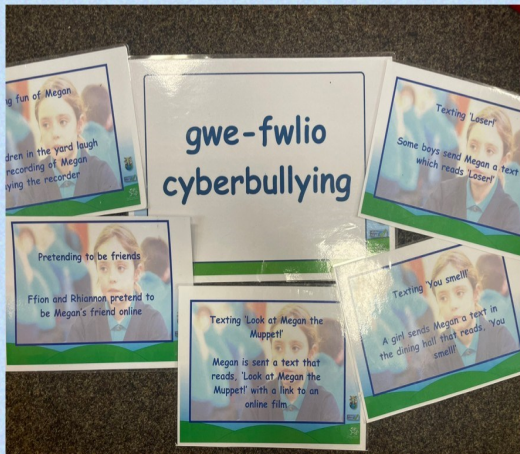
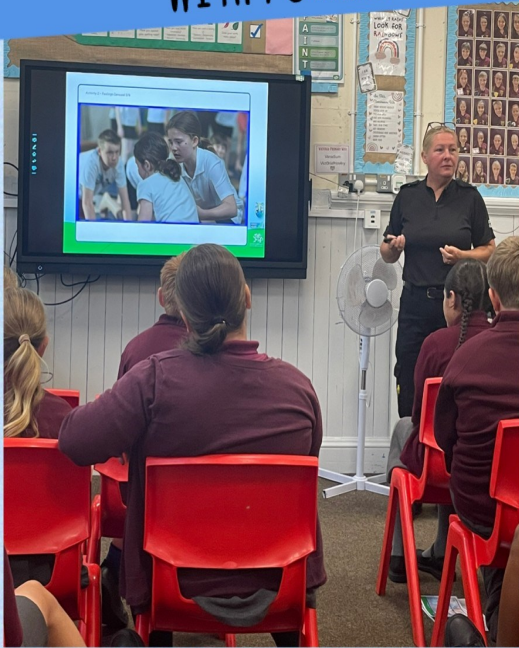
Year 6 Cyberbullying workshop
