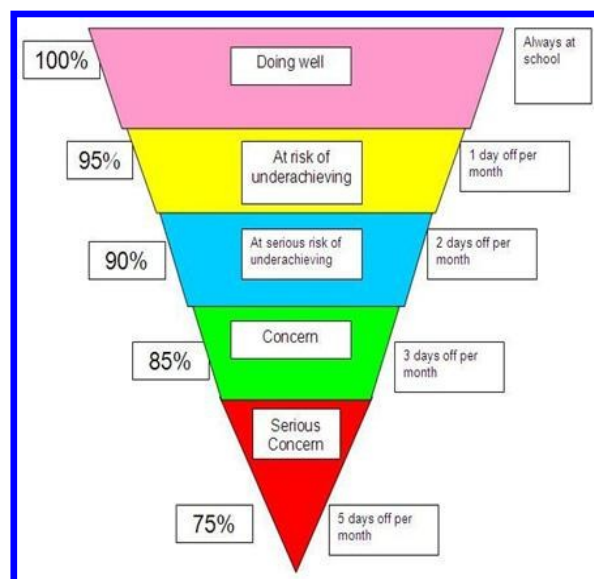
We have also noticed lots of umbrellas on the yard, which is lovely to see, but please could everyone be mindful of the spokes when moving around at drop-off and pick-up times.

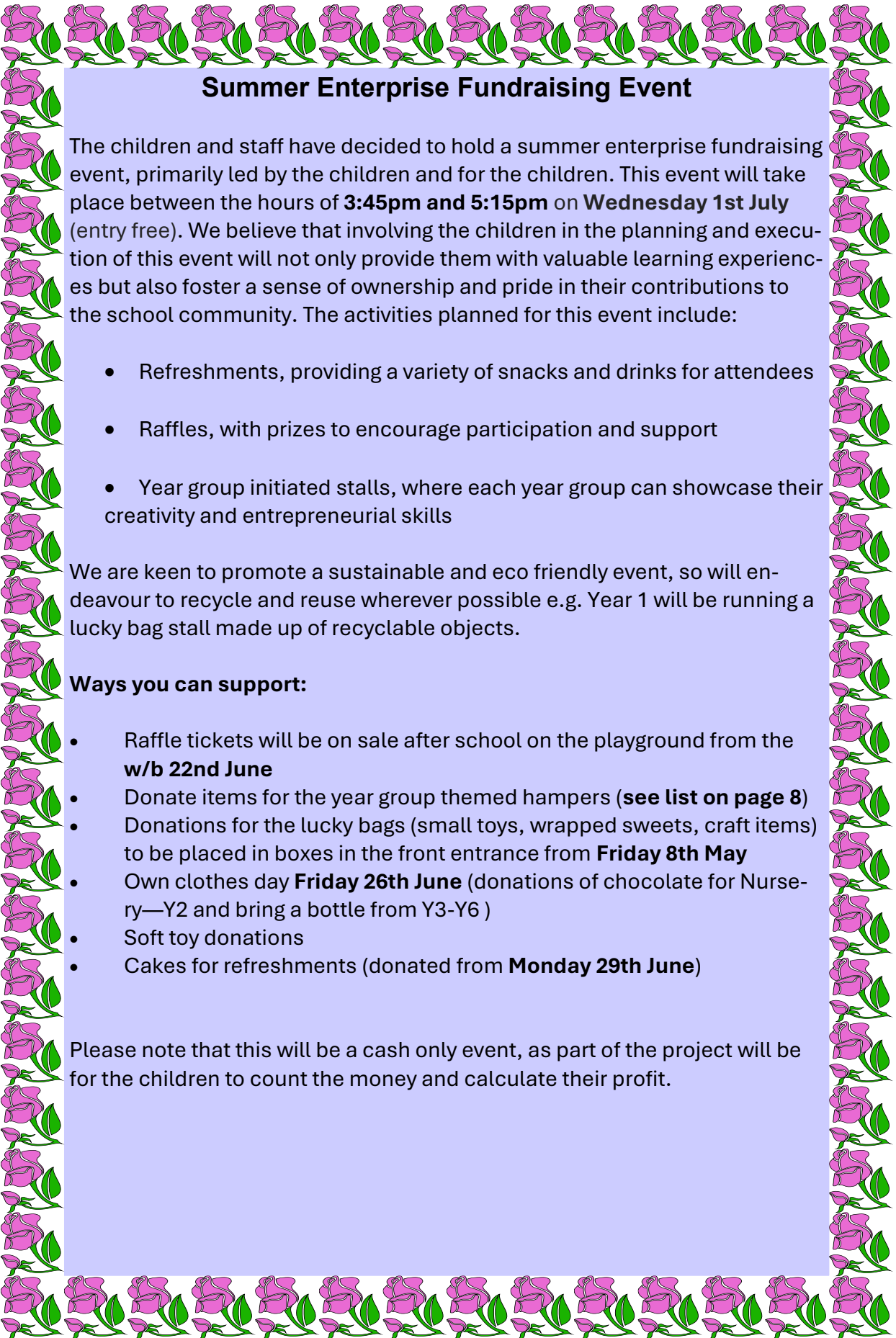
Do you know of any shops or businesses in Penarth with Welsh speaking staff?
